

ACCIDENT PREVENTION AND REHABILITATION POLICY

The management of Castle Drilling Company recognises that the Safety and Health of its employees and contractors is of the utmost importance.

To ensure this:

- Every practicable method to eliminate potential causes of accidents will be used
- Supervisory personnel are to ensure safe work practices and conditions are maintained
- Prompt reporting of occurrences such as near misses, environmental, personal injury and equipment damage
- Employees are encouraged to contribute by way of suggestion which could result in safer work practices
- All accidents will be investigated and a report compiled
- In the event of injury to personnel, Castle Drilling Company will make every practicable effort to rehabilitate that person back to their pre-injury work as a minimum.

It is the policy of Castle Drilling Company to provide the resources to ensure:

- All employees who have been injured in the course of their work receive competent medical care and attention
- That there are alternative duties to enable gradual return to work programs
- Management support in the form of employee interaction
